### PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

This is an entry-level utility engineering position. Under direction of the assigned supervisor, develops studies, designs, specifications, and drawings. Supervises subordinate technical positions for the planning and design of the gas, water, electric and sewer systems, and coordinates construction supervision activities for the City of Norwich Public Utilities and the Sewer Authority of the City of Norwich. Performs related work as required.

This is a training position to fully qualify an individual as a Utility Engineer. Associate Engineers are limited to 48 months in the position to demonstrate the skills required of the Utility Engineer. If not recommended for promotion prior to the expiration of the time limit, the Associate will be assigned to another appropriate position, if available; otherwise will be laid off with full lay off benefits.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor of Science degree in engineering with at least six months of experience in planning, design, and construction of facilities. Good knowledge of the principles and practices of mechanical, civil, or electrical engineering. Some knowledge of the field of mechanical, civil, or electrical engineering not in one's degree area.
