

MOHEGAN PARK GROUP PAVILION AREA
RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The City will provide portable toilets and a dumpster.
2. Parking is allowed in designated areas only, i.e. the open field opposite the group pavilion area or any other paved parking lot. No parking is allowed along the roadside and no parking is allowed on the blacktopped service road leading to the pavilion.
3. Boulders or stones may not be moved to allow vehicles on the grassed areas.
4. Tables may not be removed from the pavilion and placed on the grassed areas.
5. POSITIVELY NO DOGS OR OTHER TYPES OF PETS ALLOWED.
6. The consumption of beer and wine in moderation is permitted in the pavilion only.
7. Beverages are not to be dispensed in glass containers.
8. **The permit fee is not refundable should this reservation be cancelled, unless the pavilion can be rented to another group for the same day.**
9. Music from musicians, DJ's or recordings will be permitted at a moderate level. Excessively loud music from musicians or recordings WILL NOT be permitted.
10. Charcoal only may be used in the barbecue pit. Water must not be poured over coals to put out the fire.
11. Users are responsible for reasonable cleanliness of the pavilion area, although City personnel will thoroughly clean the area at the conclusion of the picnic. Refuse receptacles will be provided by the City.
12. Participants in the group picnic must conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Those who do not abide by the rules and regulations will not be granted another permit to use the facility.
13. Permits will be issued to recognized organizations and family groups only. Tickets are not to be sold outside permitted group.
14. Neither tickets nor refreshments may be sold at the permitted picnic.
15. The pavilion picnic area is open from 11:00 a.m. to sunset.
16. Posting of signs anywhere in the Park is strictly forbidden.
17. No egg tossing games allowed.
18. Games such as a coin hunt where sawdust etc. is used must be played under the pine tree.
19. Available water is not to be used for recreational purposes.
20. Pressurized string cans are NOT allowed.
21. No inflatable moonwalks, slides, etc. are allowed.
22. Per Norwich Fire Marshall Code the maximum occupancy is 300 people.
23. **PUBLIC WORKS PERSONNEL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER AND INSPECT THE PAVILION AT ANY TIME TO ENFORCE ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS.**
