MEMBERSHIP FEE REVENUES GO DIRECTLY INTO THE BUDGET TO OFFSET THE COST OF THESE INSTRUCTORS. REVENUE FROM MEMBERSHIP FEES ALSO GOES TO PROGRAMMING AND OTHER SERVICES AT THE SENIOR CENTER.
