

Effective July 1, 2009

Permit Fees

- (1) For work regulated by the State Building Code: \$35 per first \$1,000 and \$17 per each additional \$1,000 of construction value, minimum \$35, except as follows:
 - (a) Annual maintenance permit fee: \$250 in addition to required permit fees
 - (b) Mobile Homes: \$750
 - (c) Temporary installations, not exceeding 30 days: \$50 per event
- (2) Relocation of any building from one location to another: Same as new buildings
- (3) Demolition: \$25 per \$1,000 of assessed value, minimum \$35
- (4) Work performed without permits: 100 % of usual permit fees plus required permit fees
- (5) Extend an existing permit up to 180 days: \$35

Document & Other Fees

- (1) Initial plan reviews:
 - (a) 1-family or 2-family buildings: No Charge
 - (b) All other types: \$100
- (2) Subsequent plan reviews:
 - (a) 1-family or 2-family buildings: \$35
 - (b) All other types: \$50
- (3) Occupancy analysis: \$50
- (4) Applications for modification of the State Building Code: \$20
- (5) Applications to the Building Code Board of Appeals: \$100
- (6) Letters of Compliance: \$20
- (7) Certificates of Occupancy:
 - (a) R-2, R-3, R-4, 1-family and 2-family: \$50 per separate dwelling or sleeping unit
 - (b) All other use groups: \$100 per occupancy unit
 - (c) Temporary installations: \$25
- (8) Required re-inspections: \$35
- (9) Requested additional or non-permit related inspections: \$35
- (10) Inspections during other than normal business hours: \$100 per hour, minimum 1 hour
- (11) Copies:
 - (a) Photocopies: \$1 per page
 - (b) Plans or maps: \$5 per sheet

State Education Fee

- 1) Per thousand of construction value: \$0.22 (\$0.00022 per dollar)
