WHEREAS, there is on file in the Tax Collector's Office the names and addresses of the persons against whom motor vehicle taxes and personal property taxes on the Grand List of 2006 inclusive, were levied and the reasons why the Tax Collector believes such taxes are uncollectible; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Tax Collector's recommendation the aggregate sum of \$309,569.50 is the total outstanding motor vehicle tax on the Grand List of 2006 inclusive, to be transferred to the suspense tax book and \$104,461.71 is the total outstanding personal property tax on the Grand List of 2006 to be transferred to the suspense tax book; and,

WHEREAS, nothing herein contained shall be construed as an abatement of any tax transferred to the suspense tax account, but any such taxes, as it shall have been increased by interest, penalty fees and charges may be collected; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with Rossi Law Offices to pursue collection of the aforesaid accounts;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH that: the following aggregate sums representing personal property taxes of \$104,461.71 and motor vehicle taxes of \$309,569.50 on the Grand List of October 1, 2006 inclusive, be and the same hereby is transferred to the suspense account.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the following is a true and attested copy of a resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Norwich at a meeting held on February 7, 2011, and that the same has not been amended or rescinded:

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich has acquired property at 196-200 Yantic Street through a tax foreclosure, said property including a building in disrepair; and

WHEREAS, said property is in the area of the Yantic Falls and both the property and area are of historic significance; and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism has advised the city a grant may be available from it to be used to study the condition of the building and historic aspects of the site which information would be useful to the city in connection with determining the optimum use and development of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich estimates a study of this nature will cost \$35,000 and the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism may grant up to one half of that amount, \$17,500, and the Council of the City of Norwich anticipates that applications may be made to receive grants from other entities to cover the balance of the project study.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH, that

City Manager Alan H. Bergren be and hereby is authorized to apply to the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism for a grant to support a project tentatively entitled "Uncas Leap Historic Structures Report and Design Consultation" and to seek from the Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism a grant in the amount of one half of the total estimated cost of \$35,000 for such study.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norwich approved a 2010-11 Capital Budget for the Police Department vehicles in the amount of \$182,000 for the purpose of replacing police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department was able to acquire and outfit these vehicles for \$144,000; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is seeking to apply \$38,000 of its Capital Budget which had been allocated for police cruisers toward the replacement of a 4-Wheel Drive Patrol Supervisor vehicle. Said amount was obtained via State of Connecticut Department of Administrative Services Bid price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH, that the 2010-11 Capital Budget for the Police Department be amended to add the replacement of a 4-Wheel Drive Patrol Supervisor vehicle.
