THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the following is a true and attested copy of a resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Norwich at a meeting held on June 21, 2010, and that the same has not been amended or rescinded:

WHEREAS, the property located at 71 McKinley Avenue contains a structure which the City Building Official has deemed to be in imminent danger of collapse; and

WHEREAS, the City Building Official intends to have the structure demolished and removed in accordance with Section 116.4 "Emergency Work" of the Connecticut Building Code; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of demolishing this structure and removing the debris is estimated at \$10,000.
