WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norwich, by a resolution adopted January 6, 2014, recognized the efforts of the St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee to organize a St. Patrick's Day Parade to be held in downtown Norwich on Sunday, March 9, 2014, the parade funded by private contribution and sponsorship, and also recognized this St. Patrick's Day Parade as a City of Norwich function; and

WHEREAS, by all accounts the parade was a success and a second St. Patrick's Day Parade is being planned for March of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Harp & Dragon, Billy Wilson's, Chasers and various restaurants and food vendors propose to conduct a fundraiser in support of a 2015 St. Patrick's Day Parade, the fundraiser to be known as "Half Way to St. Patrick's Day" to be held from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 14, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this fundraiser will require the closing of a portion of Main Street from Broadway to Washington Street from noon until midnight on September 14, 2014 to permit set up and cleanup; and

WHEREAS, the event will involve public entertainments and the sale of a variety of foods, beer, wine and alcoholic beverages.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH, that City Manager Alan H. Bergren, subject to the approval of the Traffic Authority permitting the closure of that portion of Main Street between Broadway and Washington Street from the hours of noon to midnight on Sunday, September 14, 2014, be and hereby is authorized pursuant to Section 13-14.2 of the Norwich Code of Ordinances to grant the organizers of this fundraiser permission to sell beer, wine and alcoholic beverages on the closed section of Main

Street as described herein from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. September 14, 2014 as a fundraiser for the March 2015 St. Patrick's Day Parade in Norwich, any such sales of beer, wine or alcoholic beverages to be subject to satisfactory proof that the organizers and any vendor of beer, wine or alcoholic beverage have complied with applicable regulations of the State Liquor Commission; that the sales of beer, wine or alcoholic beverages will be made under a proper liquor license and in an area where sales are permitted under such license; that identification be mandatory for each person purchasing beer, wine or an alcoholic beverage and that the proper insurance will be obtained and maintained by the organizers and any vendor of beer, wine or alcoholic beverages at this event and that the City of Norwich be listed as an additional insured on such insurance.
