Relative to authorizing the transfer of the residual funds from previous years for the Winterfest event to the Norwich Events Organization, Inc.

WHEREAS, for the past several years, volunteers have organized the annual Winterfest activities and the City of Norwich has accounted for the revenues and expenditures of such activities; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich Winterfest account has a balance of \$5,372.82; and,

WHEREAS, the Norwich Events Organization, Inc. was approved by the Internal Revenue Service in May 2018 as an Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3) organization with a mission to “further the economic prosperity of the City of Norwich, CT and surrounding region through improvement of vibrancy and quality of life through events” and,
