Items allowed for curbside pickup:

 <p>Tires (without rims)</p>	 <p>Furniture & Mattresses</p>	 <p>Carpeting (rolled or folded)</p>
 <p>Scrap Wood (neatly stacked)</p>	 <p>Household Appliances (see exceptions, below)</p>	 <p>Metal (max. 50 pounds per piece)</p>

There are no restrictions on amount of acceptable items allowed, providing the overall pile is within the size guideline of 6 ft x 10 ft x 4ft. (about the size of a pickup truck bed.)

You must call Willimantic Waste at 860-423-4527 to schedule a pickup. Residents are entitled to two free pickups per calendar year. If you can't wait for a pickup or have already used your two free pickups, you can always bring items to the Norwich Transfer Station located on Rogers Road.

Items NOT allowed for curbside pickup (but accepted at the Norwich Transfer Station):

 <p>Electronics</p>	 <p>Appliances that contain freon (Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Freezers, Humidifiers/Dehumidifiers)</p>	 <p>Empty Propane Tanks</p>
 <p>Toilets, Sinks, Tubs, and Shower Stalls</p>	 <p>Shingles, Drywall (sheetrock) & other Construction Debris</p>	<p>Hazardous waste items are not allowed for pickup or disposal at Transfer Station</p>

The City of Norwich Transfer Station is located on Rogers Road, accessible from Wawecus Street or Wawecus Hill Road. Hours of operation are Monday - Friday from 8 AM - 3 PM; Saturday 8 AM - 1 PM.
